## 2024 air monitoring results

- Nineteen exceedances of the 24 hour average PM<sub>10</sub> in January – March 2024 verified by Katestone.
- Two exceedances over 70 µg/m<sup>3</sup> had industry contribution.
- Seventeen were natural events.

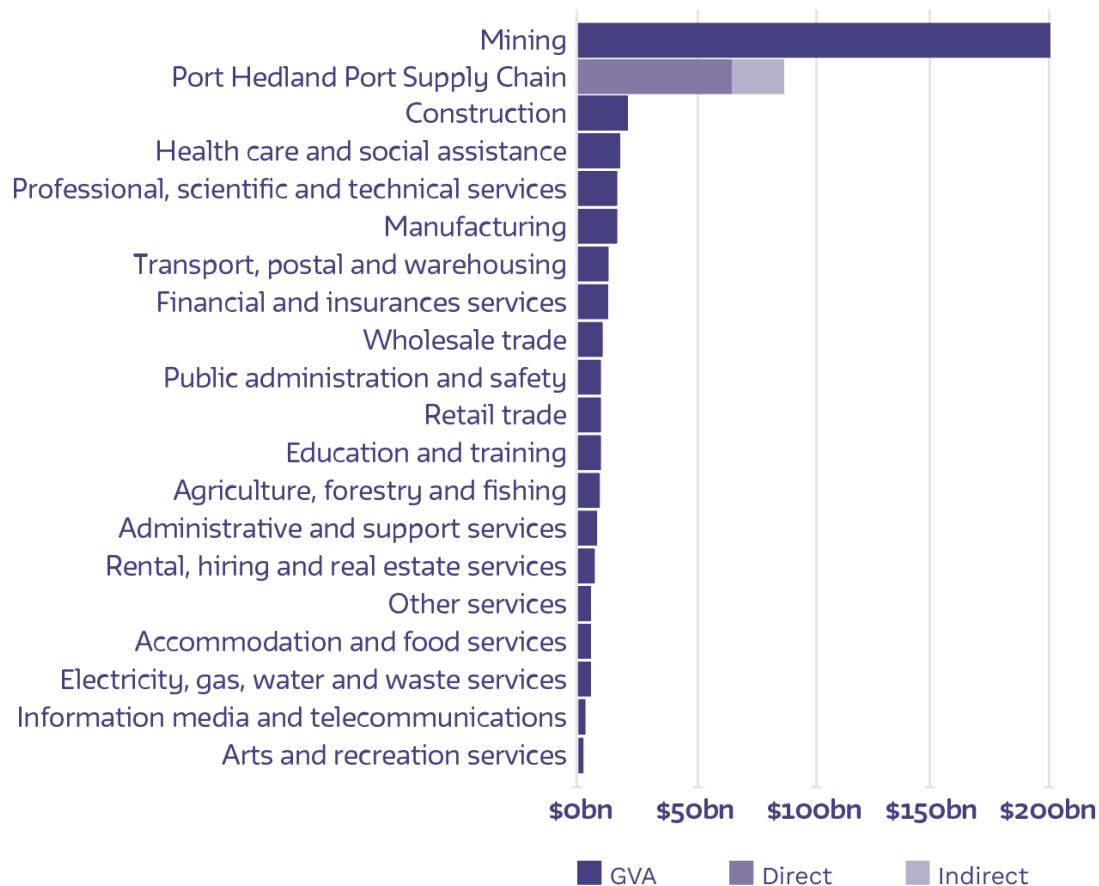
