ROY HILL

Community Grants

- Roy Hill's Community Grants Program allows eligible parties to submit applications for funding up to \$10,000 to deliver community activations and outreach activities.
- To be eligible for consideration, non-profit, sporting and recreation, and community organisation applicants must:
 - work within or provide services to communities within Roy Hill's operational footprint, namely the Town of Port Hedland or the Shire of East Pilbara
 - be incorporated or auspiced via another incorporated body
- Roy Hill's Community Grants Program will run three application per year.
- During these periods, application forms must be submitted in full to be eligible for consideration as part of the program.

Community Grants

- Roy Hill will consider funding for initiatives that address one or more of the following:
 - Engagement and development opportunities for children and youth
 - Education and training
 - Improving quality of life
 - Encouraging healthy living
 - Indigenous capacity building

Individuals, sole traders and companies are not eligible to apply for funding.
